It is often complained that the agricultural graduates lack professional competence and cut a shy figure in facing farmers. Keeping this in view the Rural Agricultural Work Experience (RAWE) is included in the program, where students will be exposed to rural (Village) environment for strengthening practical training - Group of students will be associated to farmers, agro-industrial units and agricultural research stations for this purpose for a period of 3-4 months. They will be constantly supervised and evaluated by the faculty and a detailed report of the survey and works of the students for the period is to be submitted by him.
